Reid didn't display any symptoms of cancer until January 2015. He was sitting in the kitchen with his family one evening when he looked up at something – and only his right eye turned upward. His left eye remained still.

Doctors at the local children's hospital referred Reid and his parents, Michelle and Barry, to St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. Reid's parents were terrified. "It was the worst day of our lives," said Michelle. "But the moment we arrived at St. Jude, we felt like part of the family."

Tests soon confirmed Reid had a type of cancer called rhabdomyosarcoma. "We were familiar with St. Jude," Michelle said. "We'd always donated, but we'd never set foot on campus."

Reid's dad, Barry, works for FedEx as a pilot. They've always appreciated how much FedEx does in support of St. Jude.

Reid's treatment at St. Jude included chemotherapy and proton therapy. He now visits the hospital for regular checkups. "At St. Jude, you witness miracles happen," Barry said. "St. Jude saved our son's life."

Reid's favorite things about St. Jude are playing video games in the waiting rooms and attending events that help raise awareness for the hospital. One of Reid's favorite events is the Little Loopers program, which is held during the week of the World Golf Championships-FedEx St. Jude Invitational.
